## Tips & advice

### START KNITTING

Before you start knitting, we recommend that you practice the different techniques and stitches with our tutorial videos, especially if it's your first time knitting. You can find the videos in our website

If you don't get it on your first try, don't worry, it's very common. Watch the video with your needles and wool in your hands as many times as you may need.

## Wool care instructions

Because WE ARE KNITTERS' wool is 100% wool, we recommend that you wash your garment using cold water and mild soap. Dry flat. To learn more about WE ARE KNITTERS' wool, read the CONCEPT area in our website.

## Stitch sample

It is important to do a sample before start knitting your project. The sample should measure 10cm x 10cm and needs to be done in Stockinette Stitch. If it comes be smaller, you need to knit more loosely, and if it comes out bigger, you need to tighten the stitches.

# Xmas Balls

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# XMAS BALLS

Each ball is made in one piece and in two colors: A and B. Once knitted, you will put both balls together.

## START KNITTING

### BALL #1

1. Cast on 6 stitches onto one of the wooden knitting needles with color A.

2. Knit from row 1 to 20 in the following way:

Row 1 and all the odd rows until row #9: purl all the stitches.

Row 2: \*increase 1 stitch and knit 1 stitch\*. Repeat from \* to \* until the end of the row. You should get a total of 12 stitches.

Row 4: \*increase 1 stitch and knit 2 stitches\*. Repeat from \* to \* until the end of the row. You should have a total of 18 stitches.

Row 6: \*increase 1 stitch and knit 3 stitches\*. Repeat from \* to \* until the end of the row.

Row 8: change to color B and purl the rest of the row.

Row 10: change to color A and knit the rest of the row.

Row 11: change to color B and purl the rest of the row.

Row 12: change to color A and knit the rest of the row.

Row 13: change to color B and purl the rest of the row.

Row 14: knit all the stitches.

Row 15: change to color A and knit the rest of the row.

Row 16: \*knit 2 stitches together and knit 2 stitches\*. Repeat from \* to \* until the end of the row. You should have a total of 18 stitches.

Rows 17, 19 and 21: purl all the stitches.

Row 18: \*knit 2 stitches together and knit 1 stitch\*. Repeat from \* to \* until the end of the row. You should have a total of 12 stitches.

Row 20: knit 2 stitches together six times. You should have a total of 6 stitches.

### BALL #2

To be able to make the other ball; Change when starting, color A for color B and color B for color A and follow the same steps.

## HOW TO END YOUR PROJECT

1. Cut a thread that is long enough to sew the side of the ball, thread it on the yarn needle, stitch with the needle, on the inside of stitches, use the rest of thread to close from the top.

2. Sew the sides together with the help of the little sewing needle. Tie a knot at the end with the remaining thread in order to hang the balls on your tree.
